# Terrain

A mixture of uneven surfaces, gravel, stones, and sandy conditions. A good level of fitness is required to undertake this walk. The path is close to the cliff edge, so if you have a fear of heights, then this walk is not deemed suitable. There is no shelter on the walk, so appropriate footwear and clothing is required. \*Anyone deemed not to have the suitable footwear will not be allowed to walk, as this could be hazardous to the individual and the group.
