



# South Pembrokeshire Full Day Tour

*You will be collected from your accommodation in the morning before you embark on a day out exploring South Pembrokeshire's most scenic coastline, historical castles, and iconic coastal towns.*

## Pembroke Castle

First stop will be one of Wales most impressive castles which is situated in the walled town of Pembroke. This enormous oval castle, mostly surrounded by a serene mill pond dates back to the 11th Century. Henry VII was born in this castle in 1457 and then became the King of England & head of the Tudors.



## St Govan's Chapel

Built into the side of a limestone cliff, the spectacular building is constructed from limestone, and consists of two chambers, one in the front and one in the back. Built back in the 5th or 6th century, a saint by the name of St Govan built this chapel as he fled from pirates, or so legend goes. Access to the chapel is possible by walking down the steps and then out onto the cliff. (Please note that access to this area depends on the MOD)

# Tenby

After lunch a guided walk around Tenby, this beautiful harbour town and resort. It's known for its impressive 13th-century town walls and its stretches of sandy shoreline. The iconic and busy small harbour is overlooked by a collection of pastel coloured houses and also Castle Hill, which boasts some of the most beautiful views in Tenby.



## Love Spoon Workshop

The home of genuine Welsh lovespoons that have been hand carved by The Thomas Family at The Lovespoon Workshop since 1975. The Welsh tradition of carving lovespoons as tokens of affection and love continues in Wales today. Lovespoons can be used to record various special occasions and you have a fabulous opportunity to see these being handmade in the workshop with the family.
