



## South Pembrokeshire Half Day Tour

You will be collected from your accommodation in the morning before you embark on an exciting morning exploring South Pembrokeshire's most scenic coastline, historic castles, and iconic coastal town.

### Pembroke Castle

One of Wales most impressive castles which is situated in the walled town of Pembroke. This enormous oval castle, mostly surrounded by a serene mill pond dates back to the 11th Century. Henry VII was born in this castle in 1457 and then became the King of England & head of the Tudors.



### Stackpole Quay & Barafundle Bay

Weather depending, we have an opportunity to take to the Pembrokeshire Coast Path for a fabulous 15 minute walk from Stackpole Quay to the award winning Barafundle Bay. Voted one of the top 10 beaches in the world! It is only accessible by foot or boat so is a very special spot to enjoy.



### Tenby

Enjoy a guided walk around Tenby, this beautiful harbour town and resort. It's known for its impressive 13th-century town walls and its stretches of sandy shoreline. The iconic and busy small harbour is overlooked by a collection of pastel coloured houses and also Castle Hill, which boasts some of the most beautiful views in Tenby.
