



Creative and Cultural Experiences



Storytelling Boat Trip

Myth and marine life meet on the waters of Ramsey Sound. This one-of-a-kind boat trip blends Pembrokeshire's folklore and wildlife in a setting of rare natural beauty. The voyage welcomes two award-winning talents aboard: artist and author Jackie Morris and marine biologist and writer Nicola Davies.



As you drift across Ramsey Sound and along the island's dramatic coast, hear tales of selkies and white ravens, woven between sightings of seals, seabirds, and swirling tidal races. The storytelling is immersive and poetic, enhanced by the wild rhythms of the sea itself.

Offered only on select dates throughout the season, this exclusive experience is perfect for those seeking soulful inspiration and a deeper connection to the coastline.

Coastal Printing with Sgrinhouse

Unwind by the sea with a hands-on printing experience inspired by Pembrokeshire's wild coastline. Set in the light-filled Boathouse Studio in Dale, this creative day invites you to sketch, design, and print your own linen textile, guided by the talented team at Sgrinhouse.



Begin with a gentle coastal walk to gather inspiration, then return to the studio to sketch and hand-print your own bespoke design onto beautiful Irish linen. Along the way, enjoy quiet moments, expert guidance, and a setting that soothes and inspires.

Your day includes: Coastal walk and guided sketching, hand-printing your design onto Irish linen, morning coffee and pastries, a glass of bubbles to toast your finished piece, and your printed artwork beautifully wrapped to take home. Pause midday for lunch at The Griffin (not included) or opt for a Grove picnic hamper to enjoy by the sea.

E-Bike Exploration

Embark on a self-guided adventure with one of our premium electric hybrid bikes, ideal for experiencing Pembrokeshire's countryside at your own pace. Whether you follow shaded woodland trails or glide towards panoramic coastal views, every route is designed to reveal the region's quiet charm.



In collaboration with Volt, the UK's leading e-bike brand, our cycles offer smooth, powerful assistance and a generous range of up to 60km per charge. The <u>Grove team</u> has curated three scenic routes tailored to a range of interests:

- Forest & River Trail: A shaded loop through Canaston Woods and along the Cleddau Estuary, perfect for birdwatchers and nature lovers.
- Castle & Countryside Route: A peaceful journey past Llawhaden Castle and through patchwork farmland and charming rural hamlets.
- Coastal Escape Ride: A winding back-lane trail to the sea, ideal for those wishing to pause for a beachside picnic.

Helmets are provided (medium-sized), although you're welcome to bring your own for a personalised fit. Picnics can be arranged in advance. Pre-booking is highly recommended during peak season.

Golf Day

Enjoy a timeless round on Wales's oldest links at Tenby Golf Club, just 25 minutes from Grove. Recognised as the birthplace of Welsh golf, the 18-hole course winds through sandy dunes with sweeping views of Carmarthen Bay and Caldey Island.



Perfect for players of all levels, the course offers fast, true greens and rewarding play. The sandy soil allows for excellent drainage, making it playable year-round. Facilities include a pro shop, trolley hire, and dining at The Links restaurant or 19th Hole bar. Advance bookings are required.

Note: Golfers are required to adhere to the club's dress code: standard golf attire is expected on the course, and smart casual clothing is appropriate in the clubhouse. Proper golf shoes must be worn on the course.


Guided Tours


All equipment is provided, and your guide will ensure a safe and exhilarating outing whatever your skill level.

Sea and Coastal Experiences



Ramsey Island - Private Charter

Cruise the waters of Ramsey Sound on a private guided tour around this storied RSPB reserve. You'll navigate ancient caves, ancient rock gorges and cliffs rising dramatically from the waves, while your guide shares stories of shipwrecks and legends, interwoven with fascinating details about the island's bird colonies, Atlantic grey seals, and rare geology.



One of the highlights is navigating The Bitches, a notorious tidal race renowned for its swirling waters and raw ocean power. It's a thrilling and humbling moment where nature takes centre stage.

Ideal for families, couples, or small groups seeking an unforgettable coastal experience. Windproof layers and non-slip shoes recommended. Binoculars available on request.

Skomer & Ramsey Island Wildlife Encounter – Private Charter

Sail across St Brides Bay for a two-island wildlife encounter. Begin at Skomer Island, home to 17,000 pairs of comical puffins, 360,000 Manx shearwaters, and a constellation of seabird colonies that thrive in its sheltered cliffs. Drift quietly in Skomer Harbour as puffins and guillemots dive and dart around you, while your guide shares more about this rare and protected Marine Conservation Zone.



As you sail back past Ramsey Island, expect close sightings of basking seals, coastal birdlife, and if the tide's in your favour, a glimpse of the resident harbour porpoises. The blend of open water, rare wildlife, and local storytelling makes this a truly layered and lively experience.


Best time to visit: April to early August

Grassholm Seabird, Whale & Dolphin Expedition – Private Charter



Our most exhilarating sea voyage takes you 20 miles offshore to Grassholm Island, home to 80,000 gannets, the UK's largest seabird. From there, you'll track deeper into open waters, scanning the ocean for porpoises, dolphins, and (if you're lucky) passing whales. This is a true marine safari, often described as life-affirming by returning guests. It's suitable for curious souls of all ages, though due to the offshore distance, we advise it only for children aged 8 and above unless otherwise arranged.



Sunset Shearwater Boat Trip – Private Charter




This golden-hour voyage is one of the most magical experiences on our coastline. Timed to coincide with the mass return of 360,000 Manx shearwaters, you'll sail out towards Ramsey Island in a private charter as the light softens and the sea turns silver.

With the engine stilled and the sea quiet, watch as the skies fill with shearwaters, skimming just inches above the waves, wingtips brushing the surface, forming ribbons of motion across the twilight sea. The silence, broken only by the rhythm of wings and waves, is a moment few ever forget.

This boat trip is the perfect ending to a perfect day, whether you're celebrating something special or simply embracing the beauty of stillness.

Warm layers and blankets are recommended for comfort.

Best enjoyed: May to mid-September

Foraging



Embark on a hands-on coastal journey with a renowned Pembrokeshire forager. The experience delves into the rich biodiversity of Pembrokeshire's intertidal zones. Learn to identify and harvest wild seaweeds, herbs, and shellfish along Pembrokeshire's dramatic shores.

Each 6-7 hour course ends with an open-fire cookout on the beach, where your gathered ingredients are transformed into a wild feast, cooked over a handcrafted Solva Stove —a unique experience that captures the essence of coastal living.

Tide-dependent. Location within 20 minutes of Tenby or Saundersfoot. Please wear waterproof boots and layered clothing; waterproof trousers or waders may be provided.

Vineyard Tour and Tasting



Just six miles from Grove this multi-award-winning, family-run vineyard is nestled among the rolling hills of Lampeter Velfrey. Specialising in still and sparkling wines, this boutique vineyard is a testament to the region's emerging viticulture, producing elegant wines that reflect the character of the land.

Your experience begins with a relaxed guided walk through the vineyard, learning how the vines are cultivated and harvested from the estate owners themselves. With over 4,000 vines thriving on gentle, south-facing slopes, you'll gain an insider's understanding of the journey from grape to glass.

The visit culminates with a tasting of their current vintage in the intimate visitor centre. For those wishing to linger longer, a Welsh grazing board can be added to the experience, offering local cheeses, charcuterie, chutneys, and freshly baked breads – a perfect pairing for the wine.

Tours take place on Thursdays and Saturdays from April to October and are subject to availability. Please pre-book grazing boards with 72 hours' notice.
